TESTING REQUIREMENTS

APPLIES TO ALL BIRDS ENTERING SHOW BARN

OUT OF STATE EXHIBITORS: CURRENT NPIP Active Status -OR-

Originate from a flock certified Pullorum FREE -OR- tested NEGATIVE for Pullorum Typhoid within 30 days of the show **AND** Required to have birds tested for Avian Influenza within fourteen (14) days of show

- Required to show proof of completion of required testing at check-in by STATE VET
- To avoid delays, have your documentation ready at check-in

VIRGINIA EXHIBITORS: CURRENT NPIP Active Status -OR-

Originate from a flock certified Pullorum FREE -OR- tested NEGATIVE for Pullorum Typhoid within 90 days of the show

- Required to show proof of completion of required testing at check-in by STATE VET
- To avoid delays, have your documentation ready at check-in

TAILGATE SALES: TESTING IS **NOT** REQUIRED FOR TAILGATE SALES AREA Animals in tailgate sales must be in good health, no signs of disease, injury, or neglect

 - Entry fee: \$8/bird; Double coop (Large Fowl/Large Ducks ONLY): \$14/bird
- 2. LATE ENTRIES: EMAIL ONLY received and paid by Paypal accepted Nov 2-15
 - EMAIL Entries between Nov 2-15: \$9/bird; \$16/double coop
 - Payment via PayPal must be received no later than Nov 15
- 3. Cleanup fee is required for **every** entry form from **every** person

JUNIOR SHOW

- 1. Early/On time entries must be postmarked and paid by November 1
- Entry fee: \$4/bird; Double coop (Large Fowl/Large Ducks ONLY): \$8/bird
 LATE ENTRIES: <u>BY EMAIL ONLY</u> received and paid by Paypal accepted Nov 2-15
 - EMAIL Entries between Nov 2-15: \$5/bird; \$10/double coop
 - Payment via PayPal must be received no later than Nov 15
- 3. Cleanup fee is required for every entry form from every person

TAILGATE

- Early/On time entries must be postmarked and paid by November 1: \$15 per spot
 LATE ENTRIES: EMAIL ONLY & paid via Paypal Nov 2-15: \$20 per spot
- Tailgate Sales ARE NOT restricted to animal sales.
- Animals must have proper water/food/shelter; All animals must be in good health, show no sign of disease/injury/neglect. Tailgate animals MAY NOT ENTER the show barn.
- Spot size estimated 10 ft x 10 ft; Vendors responsible for set up. (Ex. canopy, table, etc.)
- Vendor responsible for cleaning up after yourself. Please remove all trash before leaving.



RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All entries, exhibitors, and visitors are subject to these rules and regulations.:
- 2. The OPEN and JUNIOR show is open to all entries of standard and recognized nonstandard varieties of Large Fowl, Bantams, and Waterfowl.
- 3. ABA/ABA Santions:
 - a. OPEN Double Card Show is the only show sanctioned by the APA/ABA
 - b. NOT an APA/ABA show: Junior Show, Funky Chicken Class
- 4. The FUNKY Chicken Class: Must NOT meet standard or recognized nonstandard varieties.
- 5. All poultry in the show barn MUST meet state testing requirements.
- 6. Birds are entered at the sole risk of the owner.
- 7. Coop in for all poultry must be **completed** by 8:45 am, Sat., November 22.
- 8. Judging begins promptly at 9:00 am.
- 9. Fees: See all show details for fees on FEES section.
- 10. Entries accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- 11. NO Phone Entries Accepted.
- 12. Show management reserves the right to refuse or reject any entry at any time.
- 13. Cooping arrangements will be made at the discretion of show management.
- 14. Birds with signs of sickness/injury before or during the show must be removed immediately.
- 15. Awards distribution:
 - a. Entries will be judged at minimum through 3rd place.
 - b. VPBA is solely responsible for awards given specifically by the VPBA.
 - c. Awards given by other breed clubs are the responsibility of other breed clubs. Necessary announcements must be made by their club members.

16. Judging:

- a. Exhibitors will not be permitted in the aisle where judging is being conducted.
- b. Changes to this will be done at the discretion of the Judge or Show Committee.
- c. Judging for the Open Show on both the Blue and White Cards will be conducted according to the most current established standards of the Standards of Perfection published by the American Poultry Association and American Bantam Association.
- d. All protest must be made in writing to the Superintendent BEFORE the Judges leave the floor. A \$50 deposit must accompany all protests for EACH card being contested.
- 17. No person except the exhibitor, the Judge, or the Show Management shall handle or feed any bird without expressed permission of the exhibitor.
- 18. The VPBA Show Committee will use every precaution to guard against accident, mistake, loss or damage, but will not be held responsible should any occur.
- 19. Once coop-in time has passed, no bird may be removed from the show hall without the expressed permission of the Show Superintendent.
- 20. Entries submitted & paid but fail to exhibit for any reason automatically forfeit submitted fees.
- 21. Entry fees, sponsorship, and donations to the VPBA event are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- 22. Tailgate Sales: See TAILGATE SALES: VPBA offers tailgate sales area.



RULES AND REGULATIONS (Continued)

JUNIOR SHOW SPECIFICS: ADDITIONAL TO OPEN/OVERALL SHOW RULES

- 1. These Junior Show Specifics are in addition to the General Rules and Regulations.
- 2. The Junior Show is a single card show.
- 3. The Junior Show is NOT an APA/ABA sanctioned show.
 - a. Junior exhibitors will not qualify for APA or ABA point earnings.
 - b. Junior Exhibitor wanting to earn APA/ABA points need to enter the OPEN Show.
- 4. All poultry entered MUST meet state testing requirements established by VDACS.
- 5. Birds are entered at the sole risk of the owner.
- 6. FEES: See JUNIOR SHOW Fees details on the FEES pages.
- 7. Eligibility to show as a Junior:
 - a. Exhibitors between the ages of 5-17 years old.
 - b. Junior exhibitors solely responsible for cooping and grooming their own birds.
 - c. Junior exhibitors may be asked by the judge to handle their own birds.
 - d. Junior exhibitors must remain present during judging.
- 8. Awards distribution:
 - a. Entries will be judged at minimum through 3rd place.
 - b. VPBA is solely responsible for awards given specifically by the VPBA.
 - c. Junior exhibitors must be present to receive any awards they may win.
 - d. Awards given by other breed clubs are the responsibility of those clubs, not VPBA.

9. Judging:

- a. Exhibitors will not be permitted in the aisle where judging is being conducted. Any change to this will be done at the discretion of the Judge and Show Committee.
- b. Judging for the Open Show on both the Blue and White Cards will be conducted according to the most current established standards of the Standards of Perfection published by the American Poulty Association and American Bantam Association.
- c. Protests must be made in writing to the Superintendent BEFORE Judges leave the floor.

d.\$50 deposit must accompany all protests.

- 10. No person except the exhibitor, the Judge, or the Show Management shall handle or feed any bird without expressed permission of the exhibitor and/or guardian.
- 11. Exhibitors who submit entries and fail to exhibit for any reason forfeit all fees paid.
- 12. Entry fees for all aspects of the VPBA event are non-refundable.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

- 1. Juniors who wish to participate in Showmanship must mark their entry form.
- 2. Participants should have a SEPARATE bird for showmanship if they are also participating in the Junior Card show. Birds from the Junior show MAY NOT be removed until end of show.
- 3. There is no additional fee for participation in showmanship.
- 4. Volunteers where the participant or guardian is able to help to assist are requested.5. Results are submitted to YEPA. Members of YEPA will earn whatever applicable points issued by YEPA but that is the responsibility of YEPA.
- 6. The schedule for age groups will be from youngest to oldest in time blocks. By including your intent to participate will better allow the schedule to be established therefore we do request you ensure to demark the necessary block on your applicable entry form.
- 7. Participants who are absent at the time of their age groups judging will be excluded. Once the time block for the age block has passed, there will not be additional time offered.
- 8. Once all judging for each age group is complete, results will be calculated.
- 9. Results will be announced at the end of the day.
- 10. Sponsorship: Sponsors wanted for showmanship. EMAIL the club or TEXT Kelli for details.



FUNKY CHICKEN CLASS

FOR NON-STANDARD BIRDS ONLY

The VPBA is excited to again offer the non-standard Funky Chicken class for fun

Funky Chicken Entry Rules:

- Exhibitors may enter as many birds as you want under Funky Chickens
- Funky Chickens MUST NOT be an ABA/APA to standard specimen
- · If your Funky Chicken is a Standard bird, it will be immediately disqualified
- · Birds must be in good health. Blind or physically deformed are disqualified
- Entered under their PET NAME (not breed name/info)
- Live Funky Chickens still must meet ALL testing requirements of the state of VA like any and all other live birds participating in the overall poultry show

So what Funky Chickens do you have to enter?

Whether it is a project your are working on or someone snuck over the fence, you can participate in the show and have a great time with the rest of us and get experience.

Any NON-STANDARD bird could win.

Let me tell you about Cliff & Phylis Hawkes of Maine. Their primary flocks were Golden Sebrights and Black Old English game bantams. Once they had one cockerel cross between the two breeds that resulted in the cockerel having the type of a Sebright but had the rich black plumage of the OEGB and aptly named this handsome boy "The Licorice Kid". Wouldn't you know it was "The Licorice Kid" that won Champion Non-Standard many years ago at one of the first shows that did the non-standard class.














The Society for Preservation of Poultry Antiquities (SPPA) State Meet for 2025 Virginia Poultry Breeders Association (VPBA) Fall Show

We have received queries about birds missing from the list (see the website or a member's breeder's directory) or about adding birds to the list. The club will review any breed brought before them to be added to the list. However, the breed must have some history in this country. To inquire about adding a breed to the Critical List, please send us an article about the history of this breed, including their country of origin, development dates, entry into the U.S. and what happened after importation. Also, remember, we are human and nothing is perfect. If you see an error on the list, please bring it up to the president. The Virginia Poultry Breeders Association does not require you to personally participate in the exhibition of poultry. Members are not required to own poultry at all.
